## **The Baby and All Bag**



**1 Shoulder bag**



**2 Hip support**



**3 Hands free hip carrier**



**4 Hands free front carrier**

The carrier is suitable for babies  
from 7kg to 15kg or  
from approximately 6-30 months.**

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Fig 1. In general use as a shoulder bag.

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Fig 2. To use the bag as a carrier place the long shoulder strap over your head so that it is slung diagonally across your body. Adjust the strap length to suit. Take the small Y shaped back flap out of the pocket and attach the D rings to the hooks.

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Fig 3. With the the Y shaped flap already clipped up in positions the leg holes can be adjusted to suit a smaller baby by fastening the loops on the Y shaped flap to the buttons on the sides of the bag.

Fig 4. Lift your baby up to your chest and guide one leg carefully into each of the leg holes on either side of the flap. This gives you the hip support position which is very convenient and easy to use. **WARNING- YOU MUST KEEP YOUR ARM WRAPPED AROUND THE BACK OF THE CHILD AT ALL TIMES USING THIS POSITION.**

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Fig 5. To use the handsfree carrier simply lift your baby into place as for the hip support position and lift up the front flap and attach the D rings at each corner to the clips. Smooth the flap around your baby's back and adjust as necessary by pulling gently on the adjuster strap to make sure that the flap fits snugly around your baby. To spread the weight of a heavier baby when using either hip position release the top strap from the accessory comfort pad and separate the shoulder strap as shown in Figure 5.

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Fig 6.If you find it difficult to reach around your baby to do up the clip nearest the back then take the corner of the front flap that is hardest to reach and attach that D ring to one of the hooks before you lift your baby into place.

Fig 7.To use the front carrier lengthen the shoulder strap a little and open it up in a figure of eight as shown. It is useful to keep the adjuster buckle to the front. Put the crossover over your head and slip an arm into each of the holes. Adjust the straps so that they are comfortable and lying flat.

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Fig 8.Clip the inside flap in place and lift your baby into position carefully guiding one leg through each hole.

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Fig 10. The straps cross comfortably across your upper back.

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Fig 9.Clip the front flap in place ensuring that it wraps comfortably around your baby. Smooth the flap around your baby's back and adjust as necessary by pulling gently on the adjuster strap to make sure that the flap fits snugly around your baby.

Wipe clean or warm wash by hand if required.  
Hang to dry. Do not tumble dry.

Take care when bending or leaning forward.

This carrier is not suitable for use during sporting activities.

Do not leave your baby unattended with this bag.

When using the hip support position keep your arm wrapped around your baby's back at all times.

Regularly check the condition of the strap, fittings and seams of this bag and carrier to ensure they are safe and secure.

Please be aware of what you carry in the bag and the outside pockets as sharp objects, such as pens, may cause discomfort to your child.

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
