## General Information & Safety

### WARNING:

- DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED
- CHILDREN SHOULD BE PROPERLY HARNESSSED IN AT ALL TIMES
- FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY INCORRECT USE WILL CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE STROLLER
- THE HARNESS SHOULD BE CORRECTLY FITTED AND ADJUSTED. THE HARNESS IS NOT A SUBSTITUTE FOR PROPER ADULT SUPERVISION.
- DO NOT CARRY EXTRA CHILDREN OR BAGS IN THIS SEAT.
- DO NOT USE THIS SEAT WITH ANY OTHER MODEL OF PRAM OR STROLLER.
- PUT ON ALL THE BRAKES WHENEVER YOU PARK THE STROLLER.
- MAKE SURE CHILDREN ARE CLEAR OF ALL MOVING PARTS IF YOU ADJUST THE STROLLER, OTHERWISE THEY MAY BE INJURED.
- DO NOT LIFT THE MX3 STROLLER AND CHILDREN USING THE MX3 TODDLER SEAT

### CAUTION

- This seat is not recommended for children under 6 months and is not suitable for children over a height of 96cm and a weight of 15kg.
- The stroller may be unstable if it is over-loaded Do not use accessories or replacement parts other than those approved by Maclaren.
- For a compact fold remove the toddler seat before folding the stroller.
- This MX3 toddler seat is for use with the Maclaren MX3 stroller only; it should NOT be used with any other product.
- Ensure that you read the Maclaren MX3 Instruction leaflet before using the toddler seat.
- For extra safety 'D' rings are provided for attachment of a separate harness to BS6684
- Never leave a child in this seat whilst ascending or descending stairs or escalators or when travelling on other forms of transport.
- Not to be used near to an open fire or exposed flame

### Cleaning

- Clean frame with a damp cloth and mild detergent and dry thoroughly. Do not use abrasives.
- The seat and other fabric can be sponge cleaned. Allow the seat to dry naturally and thoroughly before reuse.
- Do not fold or store the product whilst wet and never store in a damp environment as this can cause mildew to form.

### Maintenance

- Do not leave in direct sunlight for extended periods
- Always check that the mechanical fixings and plastic parts are free from damage and are free to operate correctly
- Replace the seat and harness assembly if ripped or damaged in any way

## Instructions

• **YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY MAY BE AFFECTED IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS.**

### 1. ASSEMBLING/ DESEMBELING THE FRAME

- A. Open the frame.
- B. Pull the front legs forward and connect them into the armrest bar until the pop up pins are engaged.  
Pull on the legs to ensure that they are properly engaged.

### 2. ATTACHING AND DETACHING THE TODDLER SEAT TO THE MACLAREN MX3 FRAME

Before attaching the seat to the stroller ensure that the leg rest is folded down.

- A. Place the toddler seat in position, the bottom bar of the seat should rest on the footplate and the clips should rest on the stroller frame at either side.
- B. Push the side clips onto the frame and secure by closing the clip around the tube.
- C. Secure the side legs of the toddler seat to the stroller using the straps provided, wrap the strap around the seat legs and side bars of the stroller and fasten the clip.
- D. Pull the strap tight.

**CAUTION:** *The security of the fitting should be tested by pulling up on the toddler seat before putting the child into the seat. To detach the toddler seat reverse this process.*

### 3. SEAT BELT/SHOULDER HARNESS OPERATION

**WARNING:** *Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the crotch strap in combination with the waist belt and shoulder straps.*

TO FIT HARNESS:

- A. Insert both fasteners securely into clasp.
- B. Adjust strap lengths. Belt, crotch strap and harness should be snug.
- C. 'D' rings are included for an additional harness, if desired.

TO RELEASE HARNESS:

- D. Squeeze fastener prongs and pull apart.

### 4. UNFITTING AND REFITTING THE SEAT

- A. Undo the zips on the seat on both sides of the bumper bar.
- B. Undo the poppers on the crotch restraint on the front of the bumper bar.
- C. Undo the strap at the back of the seat by sliding it through the buckles.
- D. Undo the remaining straps attaching the seat to the legs and the side of the bumper bar, slide the straps through the hole in the 'D' ring.

To refit the seat, reverse this process.
